Dear Mr. Nelson:

The Umatilla County Road Department crews have completed patching Court Street Extension to the City of Pendleton's specifications; and Pioneer Construction has completed their portion of the project to comply with the City's requirements.

We, the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners, hereby request that the City of Pendleton assume jurisdiction over the County roads, or the portions thereof, on Exhibits A, B, and C attached hereto. This is in accordance with ORS 373.270.

Upon acceptance by the City of Pendleton, the County shall relinquish any and all jurisdiction over, responsibility for, and interest in the portions of the roads designated.

WHEREAS on April 3, 1991, the Board of Commissioners signed an order relinquishing certain rights-of-way or portions of rights-of-way to the City of Pendleton (portion of S.E. Third St. and S.E. Nye Ave; portion of Quinney Ave. and S.W. 44th St; S.W. Court Place);

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board of Commissioners there were mistakes in the legal descriptions within that order. The descriptions need correcting before the County can relinquish jurisdiction to the City of Pendleton.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the correct legal descriptions for those roads or portions of roads being relinquished to the City of Pendleton be revised and approved. The corrected descriptions are attached and noted as Corrected Exhibit A (S.W. Court Place), Corrected Exhibit B (S.E. Nye and a portion of S.E. Third Street); Corrected Exhibit C, a portion of S.W. Quinney Avenue and S.W. 44th Street.

EXHIBIT "B"
S. E. NYE AND S. E. 3RD STREET

Centerline description for the relinquishment of a portion of S. E. 3rd Street and S. E. Nye Avenue (County Road #991) in the City of Pendleton, OR.

BEGINNING at a point lying South $89^{\circ} 44' 50''$ West 40 feet from the S. W. corner of Block 5 of Rees Addition to the City of Pendleton; said point also being on the centerline of S. E. 3rd Street;

Thence North $0^{\circ} 2' 50''$ West along said S. E. 3rd Street centerline to its intersection with the centerline of S. E. Nye Avenue;

Thence North $78^{\circ} 28' 20''$ East along said S. E. Nye Avenue centerline to its intersection with S. E. 3rd Drive;

Thence North $89^{\circ} 58' 30''$ East along said S. E. Nye Avenue centerline to a point which lies South $0^{\circ} 0' 00''$ East 50.01 feet of the S. E. corner of Block 4 of Rees Addition to the City of Pendleton, said point being the terminus point for this description.

The right of way for which this description applies is variable in width, as shown on the Plat of Rees Addition.
