In the matter of opening County Road No 587, petitioned for by Tom A.Campbell et al, Gommneing at a point 17 rods due South of the SE corner Sec.24 Tp. 4 North Range 30 E.W.M.

Now on this 13th day of July 1906, comes the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the May 1906 term of this Court, to view, layout and report upon said proposed County road No 587, COMMENCING, at a point 17 rods due Southof the Southeast corner of Section 24, Township 4 North Range 30 EWM?running thence North on Section line between Section 19 and 24,18 and 13,17 and 12, 6 and 1, to the Northeast corner of Section 1, in said Township, and Range thence continueing North on the Section Zine between Section 31 and 36 of Township 5 North Range 30 E.W.M? to a point 115 rods due North of the Northeast corner of said Section 36 Tp 5 North Range 30 E.W.M, at that point intersecting the South Cold Spring Road, as a County Road for final hearing, the same having publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court, being publicly read the First time on July 9th 1906 and publicly read the Secon time on the 13th day of July 1906, and the said Board of Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended the opening of said road as a County Road, and the field notes and plat of survey being on file and certified to by the Surveyor appointed to survey the same, and there being no remonstrance on file against said petition, and the Court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility, it is, THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED, by the Court, that the report of the Board of County Road Viewers be accepted, and that said report, survey, and plat be recorded in the record of Plats and Field Notes for Umatilla County, in accordance with the report of said Viewers, and that the Road Sppervisor, through whose District said Road runs be and he is hereby Ordered to open the same for public travel.
