

NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO MONUMENT 2 PARCELS OF LAND THAT ARE TO BE DONATED TO UMATILLA COUNTY FOR ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR A BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT. THREE PARCELS ARE SHOWN BECAUSE THE SECTION LINE SEPARATES TWO DIFFERENT TAX LOTS AND PARCELS "A" AND "B" ON THE EASTSIDE WERE CALCULATED AND DESCRIBED SEPARATELY FOR DEED PURPOSES.
THE WESTERLY BORDERS OF PARCELS "A" AND "B" AND THE EASTERLY BORDER OF PARCEL "C" FOLLOW THE RIGHT-OF-WAY LINES OF COUNTY ROAD *1061 AS IT IS ANTICIPATED IT WILL BE LEGALIZED 11/6/96 AND IS SHOWN ON C.S. *96-71-C.

BEARING BASE USED ON THIS SURVEY WAS THE LINE BETWEEN
SECTION 1 AND 2, T. 1 SOUTH, R. 32 E.W.M. AS S 0° 32′ 20° W FROM C.S. *92-42-B BY STABLER AND *96-71-C BY THE UMATILLA COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT. INSTRUMENTS USED WERE A WILD T-16 ONE MINUTE THEODOLITE AND A WILD DI-5 EDM. MONUMENTS WERE SET

LEGAL DESCRIPTION - PARCEL "A" - ERLINE ELLIS

RADIALLY FROM THE ORIGINAL LEGALIZATION TRAVERSE POINTS.

AND BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: COMMENCING AT A BRASS-CAPPED MONUMENT MARKING THE CLOSING CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 1 AND 2, T. 1 S., R. 32 E. W.M., AND SECTION 35, T. 1 N., R. 32 E. W. M.; THENCE S 4° 35′ 53″ W, 6Ø6.39 FEET TO A 5/8-INCH IRON PIN AND THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING OF THIS DESCRIPTION; THENCE S 39° 51′ 54″ E, 66.23 FEET; THENCE S ذ 32′ 20″ W, 99.Ø3 FEET; THENCE 75.91 FEET ALONG A 637.36-FOOT RADIUS CURVE LEFT (THE LONG CHORD BEARS N 13° 44′ 14″ W, 75.86 FEET); THENCE N 17° Ø8′ 59″ W, 79.71 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING. SAID PARCEL IS LOCATED IN UMATILLA COUNTY AND CONTAINS Ø.Ø4 ACRE, MORE OR

M.; THENCE S Ø 32' 20" W, 655.31 FEET TO A 5/8-INCH IRON PIN AND THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING OF THIS DESCRIPTION; THENCE S 39' 51' 56" E, 82.92 FEET; THENCE S 9' 22' 21" E, 73.39 FEET; THENCE S 21' 24' Ø1" W, 15Ø.93 FEET; THENCE N Ø' 33' 4Ø" W, 69.55 FEET; THENCE 1Ø8.63 FEET ALONG A 637.36-FOOT RADIUS CURVE LEFT (THE LONG CHORD BEARS N 5° 26' 23" W, 108.50 FEET); THENCE N 0° 32' 20" E, 99.03 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING. 
