now on this day comes the
 report of the viewers heretofore appointed at the January term, 1895,
 of this Court, to view out and report upon the location of the above
 road as a County road for final hearing, the same having been
 read upon a previous day of the term of the Court to-wit: the
 March term, 1895, and the said viewers having reported favorably
 and recommended the establishing of the same as a County road,
 and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and
 certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same, and
 there being no remonstrance or claim for damages on file
 against said road

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said road be es-
 tablished as a County road in accordance with the report
 of said viewers, field notes and plat of survey thereof be re-
 corded as by law required and that the Supervisor through whose
 district said road runs be directed to open the same for public
 use as a County Road, and to vacate such road or parts of
 roads as petitioned for
