of Section 14 in said Twp & R. thence along the most practicable route  
to the South east corner NE<sup>4</sup> of Section Eleven (11) in said Township.  
thence due North to Dry Intervillow Creek. Thence by the nearest and  
most practicable route to intersect the County road leading from  
Pendleton to Tony Creek at a point near said Dry Intervillow Creek  
where has been planted a stake marked "R." all in Umatilla County,  
Oregon.

And it appearing to the Court that only a portion of said road has  
been opened to a width of 60 feet, while the balance of the road  
is 40 feet wide, and complaint having been made to this Court  
because said road has not been opened its entire length to a width  
of 60 feet. It is therefore considered and ordered that the Supervisors  
through whose District said road No. 382 runs, be and they are hereby  
instructed to open said Road No. 382, <sup>the entire length thereof</sup>, to a width of 60 feet and the  
Clerk of this Court is hereby instructed to notify said Supervisors of  
the making of this order.

approved and signed, whereupon Court adjourned until Saturday,  
August 14<sup>th</sup>, 1897, at 10 o'clock, a.m.
