Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard uponnthe report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the May 1908 term of this Court, to view, survey, and report upon said road No. 655, commencing at a point in the Countyh Road 10 chains Northeesterlynfrom where the said county road crosses the Furnish Ditch in the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4, Sec. 9, Tp. 3 N. R. 29 EWM.; thence by the most practicable route to the center of said Sec. 9; thence North 2 miles through the center of the North half of said Sec. 9, and continuing North through the center of Sec. 4, in said Tp. 3 N.
