Now on this day this matter on regularly to be hear and considered upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the August 1911 term of this court to survey layout and petitoned for as follows: Commencing at the southwest corner of Section 33 Township 4 N R. 29 E.W.M, thence running east along the said Township line of Township 3 and 4 North a distance of ap roximately 42 miles, to point of intersection of said township line with road now running in a northwesterly direction through that said certain canyon commonly known as Stage Gulch, and to be forty feet wide, as a county road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two diferent days of the same term of court, to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on September 6th 1911 and publicly read the second time on Sept 7th 1911, and the said Bhard of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recomended that said road be declared a county road, and the said report being on file and certified to be the surveyor who surveyed the same, and the court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility, it is hereby ordered that said report of the Board of County Road Viewers be approved and the plat and field notes be recorded in the record of plat and field notes of Umatilla County and the road Supervisor through whose district said road runs be and he is hereby ordered to open said road to public use.
