FIELD NOTES OF COUNTY ROAD NO. 704

I commence at the 1/4 Sec. corner between Sess. 16 and 21 T. 4 N., R. 28 E., W. M. At a point 30 ft. N. of said corner I set a post, 4 ft. long, 4ins. square, marked R. 704; dug pits, 18 X 18 X 12 ins., E. & W. of post, and raised mound of earth, 18 ins. high, 4 ft. base, around post.

Thence following the subdivisional section line, I run south 0.50 chs. to irrigation ditch 10 lks. wide, course N. W.

3.20 chs. to irrigation ditch 16 lks. wide, course E.

19.70 chs. to a point where we begin to parallel an irrigation ditch, 10 lks. wide, course north.

35.00 chs. to a point where we leave irrigation ditch.

44.00 chs. to U. S. R. S. "A line" canal. At a point 25 ft. N. & 25 ft. W. of the intersection of the aforesaid subdivisional section line with the said "A line" canal I set a.post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, marked R. T. 704: dug pits N. & S. of post, and raised a mound of earth, 19 ins. high, 4 ft. base, around post,
