Road Official's Report

ISSUE

Vacation of that portion of Leathers Road (County Road #1213) lying west of Canal Road (County Road #1203) and south of the A-Line Canal.

BACKGROUND

The Board of Commissioners at its July 8, 1997, meeting accepted the vacation petition from Richard and Kathryn Erz, received a preliminary report from the Public Works Department, referred the petition to the Public Works Department for further action, and scheduled a public hearing. The Public Works department placed the required legal notices and provided notice to the affected property owners and utility companies.

FACTS AND FINDINGS

The petition was accompanied by the required fee of \$500.00 plus the \$20.00 recording fee. Comments were received from two utility companies and are attached to this report. No other comments were received in favor of or against the proposed road vacation. Records show that Richard and Kathryn Erz are the owners of all abutting property, with the exception of the Hermiston Irrigation District (Bureau of Reclamation). Hermiston Irrigation District has no objection to the vacation, as they have no need for a crossing at this location. Because of the marsh-like terrain some of the right-of-way traverses and the narrowness of the right-of-way, the Public Works Department feels that a road through much of the right-of-way would be unbuildable in its existing location and is therefore of no use to the County. Ownership of vacated right-of-way would vest in the abutting property owners, in this case Richard and Kathryn Erz.

FISCAL IMPACT

Vacation would return property to the tax rolls.

RECOMMENDATION

After the public hearing on August 20, 1997, if no negative comments are received, it is recommended that the Board of Commissioners grant the vacation of that portion of County Road #1215, Leathers Road, shown in this report and described on the draft order by approving the draft order.
