WALKER ROAD LEGALIZATION REPORT

HISTORY

A portion of Walker Road was established in 1908. The ¼ mile section immediately north of Westland Road is a portion of what was originally established in 1908 as County Road No. 651 at a width of 40 feet. It ran through the center of the south ½ of Section 19 to the 1/16th corner on the range line and then turned and ran south along the range line. It makes up what are now parts of Agnew, Bloom, Walker, Westland, and Colonel Jordan Roads. The 1 mile section immediately south of Bridge Road is a portion of what was originally established as County Road No. 650, also established in 1908 at a width of 40 feet. It began at the South ¼ Corner of Section 4, Township 4 North, Range 28 E.W.M., crossed the Umatilla River, ran west to the North ¼ Corner of Section 8, turned and ran south across the River to the South ¼ corner of Section 17, ran west across the River to the southwest Corner of Section 18 on the range line, and then ran north along the range line to the Northwest Corner of Section 18. It makes up what are now parts of Bellinger, Powerline, and Walker Roads. There is a ¾-mile gap between Roads 650 and 651. No road records exist for this portion of Walker Road (see topographic map).

GENERAL

The south ¼ mile of the road being considered for this legalization is a part of old Road No. 651. However, it lies approximately 5 feet east of where it was described. This has possibly been caused by a disagreement between surveyors and property owners as to where the range line was. Current surveys are in agreement as to the location of the range line and right-of-way width in the survey for this legalization was held at 15 feet west of the range line and 25 feet east of the range line for this ¼ mile section in order to include the road surface and utilities. Width for the remaining ¾ mile was held at 50 feet, lying 25 feet on each side of the range line.

IMPACTS TO UTILITIES AND PROPERTY OWNERS

Holding the road widths previously mentioned ensures that U.E.C.A. poles and buried telephone lines remain in the right-of-way, while excluding encroachments (pivots). It should be noted that by doing so, the traveled road as it existed on the date of the survey is offset to the east by approximately 10 feet from centerline in some areas. Conversations with the Stanfield section foreman and others indicate this is due in part to farming practices on the west side of the road and westerly wind drift.


STATUTES


ORS 368.201(1) provides a basis for a county governing body to initiate proceedings to legalize a road if, through omission or defect, doubt exists as to the legal establishment of a public road. ORS 368.206(B) provides for a county governing body to legalize a road at a width in conformance with the width of roads at the time the road was

originally established, which is unknown in this case, or by standards under ORS 368.036 (60 feet per Umatilla County Ordinance). However, ORS 368.221 allows a county governing body to legalize a road at a lesser width if it is in the public interest or if encroachments are present. A pivot and buried mainline on the east side of the road would fall within a 60-foot right-of-way, but not a 50-foot right-of-way. ORS 368.041 states that unless otherwise provided under ORS 368.036, a public road that is designated as a county road after August 2, 1951, shall be 50 feet or any greater width the county governing body establishes.

RECOMMENDATION

The Public Works Department recommends that County Road No. 1231, Walker Road, located in Section 24, Township 4 North, Range 27 E.W.M., and Section 19, Township 4 North, Range 28 E.W.M., be legalized at a width of 40 feet for the south ½ mile, and a width of 50 feet for the north ¾ mile as shown on the attached survey map and as described in the final order.
