WHEREAS that portion of County Road #603, to be Vacated lies entirely within lands owned by Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company, and

WHEREAS the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners signed their Resolution of intent on September 1, 1976, and

WHEREAS a Hearing was held on October 20, 1976, as required by Oregon State Law, and

WHEREAS the Umatilla County Roadmaster testified that the portion of County Road #603 in question was useless to the general public, was of no particular use to the general County Road System, and

WHEREAS all remonstrances against the Vacation of this portion of County Road #603 was satisfied or withdrawn, now
