

FIELD NOTES OF COUNTY ROAD NO. 752.

I commence at the S. W. corner of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 33 T. 5 N., R. 29 E., W. M. At a point 20 ft. north and 20 ft. east of aforesaid point I set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, marked R. 752: dug pits 18 X 18 X 12 ins., N. & E. of post, and raised mound of earth, 18 ins. high, 4 ft. base, around post; ^{Thence following subdivisinal section line east} ~~5.55 chains irrigation ditch 4 1/2 ft. wide.~~

Thence east ~~80.53~~ chains to the S. E. corner of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 33 in said township and range, a point from which I set 20 ft. north and 20 ft. west, a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, marked R. T. 752: dug pits 18 X 18 X 12 ins. north and west of post, and raised mound of earth, 18 ins. high, 4 ft. base, around post.

I hereby certify that the foregoing field notes of County road No. 752 are correct, according to survey made by me on the 2^d day of June, 1913.
