## To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County

WE THE UNDERSIGNED, your petitioners, who are freeholders of said Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the road district, or districts, where said road is to be laid out, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located, and established a County road in said County and State,

commencing, running and terminating as follows, towit: Commencing\_at a point on the North boundary line of the right of way of the West Extension Main Canal where the west line of Section 13, T. 5 N.R. 27 E.W.M., intersects the said right of way at Station 217 plus 57, and running, in a northerly direction I370 feet more or less to a point distant 1040 feet more or less from the northwest corner of the said Section 13, thence in an easterly direction along the south boundary line of the right of way of laterals 5a and 5b to the point of intersection with the north and south center line of the south east quarter of said section 13, thence in an easterly direction along the north boundary line of the right of way of said lateral 5a to the point of intersection with the east line of said section 13, thence southerly intersection with the east line of said section 13, thence southerly 130 feet more or less to the center of the Columbia Highway as now permamently located and constructed and 435 feet more or less from the northeast corner of the said section 13.

We respectfully show that there is a public necessity for said road, in that, a large number of land owners and residents tributary to said proposed road and the public-generally-trading-therewith have-no-public-road-accessible to them, and no means of access and egress to and from their homes, but are entirely without publiconcadtfacilities, but-dependent entirely are introly without publiconcadtfacilities, but-dependent entirely upon the kindness of private land owners efxicents to pass over and through their lands.
