## IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON

## FOR UMATILLA COUNTY

In the Matter of the Establishment of a County road to be known and designated as Military Access Road, from Columbia River Highway to Oil Storage Site of the River Terminals Company, in Section 8, Twp. 5 North, Range 28 East, W.M., Umatilla County, Oregon.

FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS DAY this matter coming on for final hearing for the County Court of Umatilla County, Oregon, sitting for the transaction of county business.

And it appearing to the Court that a resolution was duly and regularly adopted by the above entitled Court on the 16th day of September, 1943, whereby this Court declared its intention to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten and change a county road on and over the hereinafter described route, to-wit:

A strip of land of variable width lying on each side of the center line of the Umatilla Oil Depot Access Road as surveyed from a point in the center of the existing Columbia River Highway to a point on southerly high bank of the Columbia River and situated in the  $NW_4^1$  of Section 16 and in the  $SW_4^1$  of Section 9, T. 5 N. R. 28 E. W. M., Umatilla County, Oregon, which said road is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the center line of said road at Engineer's Station 0450, which point is on the center line of the Columbia River Highway; said point also being 1,603 feet south and 1,325 feet east of the section corner common to Sections 8, 9, 16 and 17, T. 5 N. R. 28 E. W. M.; thence N. 0° ll' E. a distance of 3,458 feet to Station 34+58; thence on the arc of 587.2 foot radius curve left (the long chord of which bears N. 10° 10' 30" W.) a distance of 212 feet to Engineer's Station 36+70.

The widths in feet of the strip of land above referred to are as follows:

And it further appearing to the Court that said resolution was regularly heard in the County Court House at Pendleton, Umatilla County, State of Oregon, on the 18th day of October, 1943, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A. M. of said day.

And it further appearing to the Court that true copies of said resolution, certified to by the Clerk of this Court, were posted by the County Road Master of Umatilla County, Oregon, as provided by law.

And it further appearing to the Court that no objections or remonstrances to the action of said County Court have been presented or filed.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the following described road, to-wit:

A strip of land of variable width lying on each side of the center line of the Umatilla Oil Depot Access Road as surveyed from a point in the center of the existing Columbia River Highway to a point on southerly high bank of the Columbia River and situated in the  $NW_4^+$  of Section 16 and in the  $SW_4^+$  of Section 9, T. 5 N. R. 28 E. W. M., Umatilla County, Oregon, which said road is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the center line of said road at Engineer's Station 0450, which point is on the center line of the Columbia River Highway; said point also being 1,603 feet south and 1,325 feet east of the section corner common to Sections 8, 9, 16 and 17, T. 5 N. R. 28 E. W. M.; thence N. 0° 11' E. a distance of 3,458 feet to Station 34458; thence on the arc of 587.2 foot radius curve left (the long chord of which bears N. 10° 10' 30" W.) a distance of 212 feet to Engineer's Station 36470.
