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<u>ISSUE</u>

The City of Umatilla, by letter dated July 2, 2014, has requested that Umatilla County transfer ownership of Tax Lot 5N 28 17BD 2700 to the City in return for the City assuming jurisdiction over portions of Bud Draper Drive (County Road No. 1289), Roxbury Road (County Road No. 1292), and Beach Access Road (County Road No. 1285). A formal ordinance requesting the transfer should have been completed by the time of this hearing.

All of the documents establishing the roads are attached to this report. Descriptions on the road transfer are based on these documents.

RECOMMENDATION

The Public Works Department recommends that ownership of Tax Lot 2700 (a.k.a. Lot 1 of the "Replat of Lots 1,2,3,4,5, and 6, Block 76, Wardwell's Addition to the City of Umatilla") and jurisdiction over those portions of Bud Draper Drive, Roxbury Road, and Beach Access Road shown on the attached drawings and described in the transfer order be transferred to the City of Umatilla.

The County of Umatilla's intent was to place the cenacquisition. The county of umatilia's intent was to place the cen-terline of this new road along a line 320 feet easterly of and parallel to the easterly boundary of the McNary Golf Course, said line also being an ownership boundary line previously referred to as "the easterly line of that certain real property conveyed to Jerry D. and Lucinda J. The Courty also derived for the midth of the side County also desired for the right-of-way to intersect U.S. Highway 730 As it was necessary to establish the centerline of County Road 625 in the course of this survey, several groups of monuments were eva-luated in this centerline determination. We decided to utilize a series of railroad spikes on the road centerline previously referred to in a survey by Donald Staebler for the Norpa Development Co. in March of 1976 and recorded in the Umatilla County Surveyor's office as No. K-56-C. It should be noted that the centerline of County Road 625 is not parallel with the northerly boundary line of the McNary Golf Course as was previously noted in a survey by W.B. Wells for the Umatilla Golf and Country Club, recorded in the Umatilla County Surveyor's Office as We utilized the monuments shown on this same survey by W.B. Wells for the determination of the easterly line of the McNary Golf Course. EXHIBIT A LEGAL DESCRIPTION NEW RIGHT-OF-WAY BEACH ACCESS ROAD

A parcel of land in the Southeast One-quarter of Section 14, Township 5 North, Range 28 East of the Willamette Meridian, Umatilla County, Oregon, a part of Parcel 1 of Partition Plat No. 1994-27 of the Umatilla Records. Re: Transfer of Responsibility for Certain County Roads within the Umatilla UGA

Dear County Commissioners:

We are aware that the County has long wanted to shift responsibility for County roads within municipal city limits or UGAs to the respective local jurisdictions. There are many such roads in Umatilla, but only some that approach the standards that we deem acceptable for assumption of that responsibility. In any case, the City of Umatilla still seeks a quid pro quo for the transfer of these roads.

Those roads that we have identified as acceptable are Beach Access Road, Bud Draper Road and Roxbury Road within the Port of Umatilla. Both Beach Access and Bud Draper Road are built to an industrial standard that bodes well for future durability. Roxbury Road is less durable, but overlies some significant municipal utility infrastructure so also qualifies for acceptance of responsibility by the City.

In exchange for taking these roads off your hands we would like to acquire from Umatilla County the ownership of the one half block south of 5th Street between G and H Streets in Umatilla, 5N2817-BD-02700. We are interested in the parcels for future park development north of City Hall.

If this is acceptable to you we will immediately commence the processes necessary to make this happen. I am sure that Mr. Fellows for the County and Mr. Pelleberg for the City can work out any of the technical issues. The legal issues can be addressed by our respective counsel. Political issues will undoubtedly be addressed through you and our City Council.

We look forward to working with you for the benefit of all.

Dear Mr. Roberts:

I have received your letter of August 6th regarding the transfer of jurisdiction of Beach Access Road, Roxbury Road and Bud Draper Driver. I can have an ordinance for approval at our September 2nd Council Meeting requesting this transfer. The ordinance will, of necessity, refer to the transfer of ownership of County land north of the Umatilla City Hall on 5th Street as a condition of the transfer. I know that you are dealing strictly with the road component, but we don't want to lose sight of this important consideration.

Regarding Beach Access Road, you are correct. We are not interested in the road to the McNary Beach Park or the newly constructed port road which I believe is called Grain Grower Lane. Generally speaking it is Beach Access from 730 to Roxbury, Roxbury to Bud Draper and Bud Draper back to 730.

I will put the September 17th hearing on my calendar. I presume that is a daytime meeting but will check on the time in any case.
