KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Oregon, in consideration of the sum of One and 00/100 (\$1.00) Dollar to it paid by the County of Umatilla, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said County of Umatilla, an easement over the property of the grantor at Echo, Umatilla County, Oregon, the boundaries of said easement being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the Southwesterly right of way line of the O.W.R.R. & N. Company's station grounds and the center line of Kennedy Street in the City of Echo, Umatilla County, Oregon; thence N. 32 Deg. 07' W. along the southwesterly line of said station grounds, a distance of 23.5 feet; thence N. 89 deg. 06' E., a distance of 3.38 feet; thence on a curve to the right, having a radius of 306.8 feet, to a point in the Southeast-erly line of said station grounds; thence S. 57 deg. 53' W. along the said southeasterly line of station grounds to the to the southwesterly corner thereof; thence N. 32 deg. 07' W. along the southwesterly line of said station grounds to the place of beginning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said easement unto the said County of Umatilla, so long as the same shall be used for County highway purposes, and whenever the same shall cease to be used as a highway, then all right, title, and interest of said County shall cease and determine.
