It is therefore ordered that the report of said viewers be accepted and that the said road be established as a County road in accordance with the report of said viewers, and that the said report, field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required, and that the supervisor through whose District said road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a County Road.

Corner, Sec 7, in Twp 2 N R 32 E 97 m, thence in a westerly direction following the old traveled road from James Daniels place to Barnhart Station as near as most practicable for an easy grade through Sec 7 in Twp 2 N R 32 E 97 m and Secs 12 and 13 in Twp 2 N R 31 E 97 m, to a point 17 rods north of the SW corner Sec 12, in Twp 2 N R 31 E 97 m.

Now on this day comes the report of the viewers heretofore appointed to view out and assess the damages in the cases of those persons having claims in for damages to their lands by reason of the location of the proposed County road No 496, through the same, assessing said damages at \$40<sup>00</sup> to Mrs Sarah Thompson, and the matter coming up for final hearing the same having been read at a term, to-wit: the May term, 1898, of said Court, and the viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishing of the same as a County road, and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same.

It is therefore considered, ordered and adjudged by the Court that the said road be established as a County road in accordance with the report of said viewers, and that the field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required, and the road ordered opened when the damages assessed by the viewers be paid by the petitioners.
