WHEREAS a new roadway known as County Road No. 492 has been constructed across Pacific's right of way, which road location is further defined on Pacific's Drawing 500 E-5X-184 (Change 1), attached hereto and hereby made a part hereof, and said roadway having been deeded to the County of Umatilla by Oregon-Washington Railroad and Navigation Company by that certain document dated July 3, 1975, and accepted by the County Commissioners of Umatilla County on August 8, 1975;

NOW, THEREFORE, Pacific hereby consents to the use by Applicant of said roadway for the purposes hereinabove set forth, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Applicant shall maintain said roadway in such a manner as will not interfere with Pacific's use thereof, endanger Pacific's facilities installed therein, or create an infraction of any statute, ordinance, rule or regulation applicable to the operation and maintenance of Pacific's facilities.
- 2. Applicant shall occupy said roadway at its sole risk and expense.
- 3. Except as expressly set forth therein, this agreement shall not alter, modify or terminate Pacific's right to use said lands for all of the purposes for which said right was acquired. Applicant acknowledges the priority of Pacific's right over the right of Applicant pursuant to this agreement.
- 4. Notwithstanding anything contained herein, Applicant agrees to reimburse Pacific for any damage to Pacific's facilities resulting from Applicant's use of said lands.

This agreement shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the heirs, successors and assigns of the parties hereto.
