Now on this day comes the report of Jas H. Horutz, W.W. Whitworth and S. J. Lisle, heretofore appointed at the Sept 1901 Term of this Court to view out and report upon the change of said road from 60 ft to 40 ft. for final hearing the same having been read upon a former day of this Court to-wit the Nov. 1901 term.

And the said viewers having reported favorable for the change of said road and there being no petition or remonstrance on file against the granting of the same and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and certified to by the surveyor or appointed to survey the same and there being no claim for damages against said road.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the report of said viewers be accepted and that said road be changed from a 60 ft road to a 40 ft road and that said report and field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required and the supervisor through whose district said road runs be notified of said change.
