at its last regular term and viewers and
surveyors appointed but owing to the
illness of Jno. C. Arnold surveyor the said
road has not been surveyed by law
required.

It is therefore considered, ordered,
and adjudged that the above mentioned
road be and the same is hereby continu-
ed for the term and the same survey
and viewers be reappointed to report
at the next regular term of this Court.

and it further appearing from said report that
said viewers have estimated the damages to the
land of J. P. Whitemore to be \$75⁰⁰

And it also appearing to the Court that the viewers
heretofore appointed to view out and upon the
location of the above mentioned road duly made
their report at the Sept. term 1890 of this Court
that said viewers reported favorably and recommended
the location of the above mentioned road
as a County road, and the field notes and
plat of survey of said road being duly on file and
certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey
the same.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that
the report of said viewers be accepted and that
the road be established in accordance with
said report and the report of said viewers,
field notes and plat of survey thereof be record-
ed as by law required upon payment by the
petitioner herein to said J. P. Whitemore or his attorney
\$75⁰⁰ as awarded him as damages by the said
viewers T. B. Wells and J. S. McLeod and the satisfac-
tion of said sum having been paid to be filed
with the clerk of this Court by the petitioner
herein.

And upon said satisfaction of the
payment of said damages being filed as ordered
the road supervisors through whose districts
said road runs be directed to open the same
for public use as a County Road.
