IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON, FOR THE COUNTY OF UMATILLA.

In the matter of opening County Road No. 595, petitioned forbby C.J.Gulliford et al, COMMENCING, at a point where the center of Garfield St. Echo, Whitworth'S Add Echo intersects with the O.R.& N.CO right of way.

Now on this 13th day of July, 1906, comes the report of the County Board of Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at this Term of Court to view, layout and report upon said proposed County Road No. 595, COMMENCING at a point where the center of Garfield Street, "hitworth's Add. Echo, Oregon, intersects with the O.R.& N CO'S. Right of way, at the South end of said Garfield St., thence South 5 degrees West across said Right of way 2.80 chains, thence South 31 degrees and 45 minutes must parallel with the aforesaid right- of-way, 38 chains to intersect the County road at the O.R.& N.Crossing, as a County road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court, being publicly read the first time on July 10th 1906 and publicly read the second time on July 13th 1906, and the said Board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recomended the opening of said road as a County road, and the fielad notes and plat of survey being on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same, and there being no remonstrance on file against said petition, and the Court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility, it is, THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED, by the Court , that the report of the Board of County Road Viewers be accepted, and that said report, survey, and plat be recorded in the record of Plats and Field Notes of Umatilla County, in accordance with the report of said Viewers, and that the Road Supervisor through whose District said road runs be and he is hereby Ordered to open the same for public travel.
