and after due proclamation of the opening of Court by the proper officer
the following business was transacted, together with claims allowed
as shown by abstract of Claims Book No 3.

In the matter of County Road
commencing 80 rods North of the S.E. cor.
of Sec. 12, in Tp. 2, S.R. 32 E.W.M. thence
southeasterly following the present trav-
eled road up East Birch Creek, through
Tp. 2, S.R. 33, E.W.M. to a point S 75° 15' W
11 35' Lks distant from the N.E. cor. of Sec. 30
in Tp 2 S.R. 34 E.W.M. and there intersects
the ridge road which is also the western
terminus of the Union County Road from
Hilgard to the County line between Union
and Umatilla Counties, Oregon.

Now on this day comes the report of the viewers, Herbert
Bolin, J. D. Waugh and Lewis Gault, heretofore appointed at the Sept.
1898, term of this Court to view out and report upon the location of the
above Road as a County Road for final hearing, the same having
been read upon a previous day of this Court to-wit: the November
term, 1898. said road being described as follows: Commencing 80 rods
North of the S.E. corner of Section 12 in Tp 2 S.R. 32 E.W.M. thence southe-
asterly following the present traveled road up East Birch Creek through
Tp 2, S.R. 33 E.W.M. to a point S 75° 15' W 11 35' Lks distant from the
N.E. corner of Sec. 30 in Tp 2 S.R. 34 E.W.M. and there intersects the
ridge road which is also the western terminus of the Union County Road
from Hilgard to the County line between Union and Umatilla Counties,
Oregon. said road to be 40 feet wide, and the said viewers having re-
ported favorably and recommended the establishing of the same as a
County road, and the field notes and plot of survey being duly on
file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same
and there being no remonstrance or claim for damages on file

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against said road.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the report of said viewers be accepted and that the said road be established as a County Road in accordance with the report of said viewers, and that the said report, field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required, and that the Supervisor through whose District said road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a County Road.

Now on this day comes the report of the viewers J. Barnhart,
J. M. Ferguson and W. D. Stans for heretofore appointed at the September
Term, 1898 of this Court to view out and report upon the advisability
of the discontinuing and vacating of the above road for final hearing,
the same having been read upon a previous day of this Court to wit:
the Nov. term, 1898. said road being described as follows: Commencing
at the S.W. cor. of the N.W.⁴ of Sec 14, Tp 1 N.R. 32 E.W.M. and thence
N. near the N.W. corner of Sec 11, thence Northwesterly to the S.W. corner
of the N.W.⁴ of the N.E.⁴ of Sec 3. Said road being 60 feet wide, and the
viewers having reported favorably and recommended the vacating
of said road with the exception of 15⁸⁰ chains between angle No. 7 and
terminus of said road, and the field notes and plat of survey being duly
on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same
and there being no remonstrance or claim for damages on file against
said record.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the report of said viewers be
accepted and that the said road be vacated and discontinued as set forth
in the report of the viewers, and that the said report, field notes, and
plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required, and that the
Supervisor through whose District said road runs be directed to close
the same.
