Now on this day comes the report of the viewers W. D.  
Hounsford, J. S. McLeod, and J. Barnhart heretofore appointed  
at the September term of this Court to view out and report upon  
the location of said above road as a County road. For final hear-  
ing, the same having been read at a former day of this term  
of Court, and the said viewers having reported favorable  
and recommended the establishing of the same as a County  
road and the field notes and plat of survey being duly  
on file and duly certified to by the Surveyor appointed to  
survey the same and there being no remonstrance or claim  
for damages on file against said road

It is therefore ordered by the Court, that the report of said  
viewers be accepted, and that said road be established as  
a County road in accordance with the report of said  
viewers and that the said field notes and plat of survey  
thereof be <sup>recorded as</sup> required by law, and the Supervisor through  
whose district said road runs be directed to open the same  
for public use as a County road.

Now on this day comes the report of the viewers, J. B. French  
Donald Ross, and A. R. Cole, heretofore appointed at the September term  
of this Court to view out and report upon the location of said above  
road as a County Road, for final hearing, the same having been  
read at a former day of this term, of Court, and the said viewers hav-  
ing reported favorable, and recommended the establishing of the  
same, as a County Road and the field notes and plat of survey  
being duly on file, and duly certified to by the Surveyor appointed  
to survey the same, and there being no remonstrance or claim

for damages on file against said road

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the report of said viewers be accepted and that said road be established as a County road in accordance with the report of said viewers and that the said field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as required by law and the Supervisor through whose district said Road runs or directed to open the same for public use as a County Road
