WHEREAS on May 16, 1978, the U. S. Forest Service through it's Supervisor H. B. Rudolph petitioned the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners to Vacate a portion of County Road #429 as described below:

> Beginning at the junction of Forest Service Road S-524 and County Road #429, in the NE¹/₄ of the SW¹/₄ of Section 2, Township 5 South, Range 33 East; Thence running in an Easterly direction through the N¹/₂ of the S¹/₂ of Section 2; Thence Southeasterly through the SW¹/₄ of Section 1, Township 5 South, Range 33 East, terminating at the junction of County Road #429 and County Road #917 (Lehman Springs Road).

WHEREAS on September 2, 1978, a Public Hearing, as required by O.R.S. 368.575, was held in Room 114 of the Umatilla County Courthouse, and

WHEREAS the Umatilla County Roadmaster testified that the portion of County Road #429

requested to be Vacated was no longer maintained by the County and was not of any use to the

County Road System, and

WHEREAS Fancho Stubblefield and the Forest Service testified in favor of the Vac-

ation, and

WHEREAS Don Surry testified that old roads such as these although not maintain should be retained by the public bodies for hunting and recreation, and

WHEREAS the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners after much discussion decided to grant the petition, now

THEREFORE, the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners, finding it in the best interest of Umatilla County, Order that the petition to Vacate a portion of County Road #429 be approved as petitioned. However, the Vacating of this right-of-way does not negate rights of any Utilities now utilizing said right-of-way for utility purposes, particularly those rights

of Columbia Power Co-op of Monument, Oregon.
