Commencing at the Northwest corner of the bridge across Spring Creek East of the house and home of Fancho Stubblefield at Lehman Springs in Section 12, Tp. 5 South of Range 33, E. W. M., in Umatilla County, Cregon and running thence in a direction West of North 1700 feet on the old road past a pine tree which stands 30 feet East of said old road and which tree is marked with a Forest Service location poster; then continuing 600 feet, more or less, on said old road in a direction West of North to a cattle guard on said old road; then leaving said old road at said point and crossing the north line of the Lehman Springs property in a direction West of North on a line parallel to Spring Creek to a point 1700 feet; thence through a fence at said point 300 feet Westerly from Spring Creek; then continuing 1200 feet in said direction West of North to where Spring Creek empties into Camas Creek; from there 300 feet Northerly to intersect with the new Forest road running from Ukiah in the direction of La Grande in Umion County, Oregon, said last described point being 300 feet down Camas Creek from a new Forest gate built across said Forest road.
