Now on this day comes the report of the viewers appointed at the July Term 1886 of this Court to view out and report upon the location of the above mentioned road as a County road for final hearing the same having been made upon a previous day of this term of this Court to wit Sept Term 1886 and the viewers having reported favorably and recommending the establishing of said road as a County road and the plat of survey and field notes being duly on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same:

Also comes the petition of James Jones praying this Court to appoint viewers to view out and assess the damages sustained by reason of the creation of said proposed road the said James Jones claiming damages in the sum of Five Hundred dollars

It is therefore ordered by the Court that Wm Fraker George Frantz and George Strahorn be and they are hereby appointed to view out and estimate as to the damages sustained by the establishing of the said proposed road as a County road to the lands of James Jones as aforesaid and that they meet at the house of James Jones aforesaid on the 16th day of October 1886 and that they report their doings to this Court at the next regular term thereof to wit the January term 1887 and that they duly qualify before entering upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf.
