Term, 1894 and the said Viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishing of the same as a County road, and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and certified to by the Surveyor appointed to survey the same, and there being no remonstrance or claim for damages on file against said road.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said road be established as a County road in accordance with the report of said viewers, and that the report of said Viewers, field notes and plat of survey thereof, be recorded as by law required, and that the Supervisor through whose district said road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a County Road, and to vacate such roads, or parts of roads as desired vacated by said petitioners.
