It is therefore ordered by the Court that the said report of said viewers be accepted and that said road be established as a County Road in accordance with said report and that the report of said viewers, field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required. And that the Road Supervisors through whose District said road passes be directed to open the same for public use as a County Road.

In the matter of a County Road commencing at the Alby Cabin, and running by intermediate points to a point on the County line between Umatilla and Grant Counties where the proposed road running from Duffey's Spring in Grant County to the North fork of John Day River intersects said County Road.

Now on this day comes the report of Wm Howard, James Ripley and E. Bristow viewers heretofore appointed at the Sept 1 1883 term of this Court to view out and report upon the location of the above mentioned road as a County Road for final hearing the same having been read upon a previous day of this term of this Court to-wit Jan'y term 1884 and the said viewers having reported favorably and recommending the establishing of the same as a County Road, and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and certified to by the Surveyor appointed to survey the same and there being no remonstrance on file against said road.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the said report of said viewers be accepted and that said road be established as a County Road in accordance with said report, and that the report of said viewers, field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required.
