1, Ronald V. McKinnis, being a Registered Professional Surveyor of the State of Oregon, certify that I have correctly Surveyed and Monumented the lands depicted on this Plat, and that this Plat meets all the requirements as established by Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapter 92.

Revised Statutes, Chapter 92. This survey is based on the original Partition survey by Flowers, in the City of Milton-Freewater. The Basis of Bearing for this survey was the found monuments set by Flowers as shown on the Plat (Basis as calculated from Flowers Plat). The purpose of the survey was to divide Parcel 3 of Partition Plat 1997-35 for Humbert's into two new Parcels, one being a 1.00 acre Parcel for the potential development of a Head Start School. I divided the Original Parcel 3 of Partition Plat 1997-35 as: Parcel 2 for the 1.00 acre Head Start development and Parcel 1 as the remaining 5.78 acres as depicted on the face of this plat. A new roadway dedication was created on the new Parcel 1 to extend Key Boulevard to provide access and egress from the existing end of Key Boulevard to the North end of the new Parcel 2. The roadway dedication amounted to 0.34 acres removed from Parcel 1. The City requested that we make an outside curve transition for the 30.00'70.00' C.L. to 30.00'/20.00' C.L. I bisected the outside ROW curve, intersected the two resulting bearings and created a curve with a matching tangent length from the intersection point to the south line of the Parcel. This left the remaining tangent length to bring the two curves together. The existing 25' easement was dedicated to the City of Milton-Freewater from the Port of Umatilia In document 1999-350385 as filed in the Office of County Records of Umatilia County. The recording also contained a Temporary 25' construction easement which expired on June 30th of 1999 and is no longer encumbering the parcels. As a result of new construction along South Main Street, 1 did not find any of the original monuments as shown on Flowers Plat along South Main Street 1. I full find the witness corners as described by Flowers in Partition Plat 1997-35 for the square to tadjacent to South Main Street but none of the monuments along the street right of way.
