


SURVEY NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO RECOVER OR REPLACE STREET INTERSECTION MONUMENTS ON MAIN STREET IN ADAMS AFTER THE COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT OVERLAYED THE STREET FOR THE CITY. THE PVC PIPE SET OVER THE TOP OF THE IRON PIPE AT THE INTERSECTION OF MAIN STREET AND THE EAST-WEST CENTERLINE OF SECTION 4 WAS UNCOVERED AND TIED IN AFTER PAVING. THE STONE WITH "X" SET IN A MONUMENT BOX AT THE CENTERLINE INTERSECTION OF MAIN AND PRESTON STREETS WAS TIED IN PRIOR TO PAVING. THE NAILS AT WADE AND MAIN STREETS AND CENTER AND MAIN STREETS WERE NOT TIED IN BEFORE PAVING. THE POSITION OF THE NEW NAILS SET AT THESE TWO LOCATIONS WERE BASED ON THE RECORD DISTANCES FROM SURVEY NO. 03-133-B BY BILL WELLS, WHICH WAS ALSO THE BEARING BASE FOR THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED USING A SOKKIA RADIAN GPS SYSTEM OPERATED IN RTK MODE.
