## NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

This survey was performed at the request of Mrs. Karlene Hatley. The purpose of the survey was to locate the corners of Lots 6 and 10 of Block E. Town of Ukiah.

I established the boundary from the found monuments from County Survey 0-2-C as shown. The monuments from 0-2-C were laid out in 1977 at right angles and record distances based on ties to found monuments and angles calculated from the original plat. A survey done in Block C in 1962 by Stan Wallulis shows angles of 90 17 15 in the Plaza square. It appears that the 1962 bearing was calculated by applying a distance – distance intersect to two found monuments using the record plat distances. One of the monuments used was the concrete monument at the center 1\4 corner. There have been several surveys which show that that monument house. There have been several surveys which show that that monument had been disturbed. I agree with Survey 0-2-C that the angles should have been at 90°. The resulting corner locations fit the existing possessory structures very well.
