
RECORD OF SURVEY

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF JOHN LEHMAN, MEADOW OUTDOOR ADVERTISING, TO RETRACE THE ORIGINAL SURVEY DONE BY KRUMBEIN ENGINEERING FOR JOHN SHERRER IN FEBRUARY OF 1976, AND RESET THE NORTHEASTERLY CORNIERS OF SAID SURVEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING A NEW SIGN BASE. THE BASIS OF THIS SURVEY ORIGINATED FROM THE PLAT OF RESERVATION ADDITION TO THE CITY OF PENDLETON. DON STAEBLER PERFORMED A SURVEY IN 1974 WHICH MONUMENTED THE SOUTHERLY END OF BLOCK 32, WHICH WAS FOLLOWED BY THE KRUMBEIN ENGINEERING SURVEY WHICH ESTABLISHED AN IRREGULAR SHAPED LOT, WHICH INCLUDED BLOCK 32, AND OVER INTO BLOCK 202 OF SAME SAID ADDITION, WHICH IS CURRENTLY INHABITED BY THE ECONO LODGE MOTEL. I TIED INTO THE UMATILLA COUNTY PROJECT PLCP 2003, PERFORMED BY WILLIAM R. WELLS, WHICH ESTABLISHED OREGON NORTH STATE PLANE COORDINATES ON MANY MONUMENTS THROUGHOUT THE CITY OF PENDLETON. I UTILIZED THE COORDINATE/BEARING BASE OF SAID SURVEY AND ROTATED BACK TO THE BEARINGS OF RECORD SHOWN ON KRUMBEIN'S SURVEY MAP NO. K-75-B.

KRUMBEIN'S SURVEY WAS PERFORMED PRIOR TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE ECONOLODGE AND NO MONUMENTS THAT WERE SET ON THE SITE WERE FOUND.
