NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

THIS SURVEY WAS ORDERED BY BILL COLE, OWNER, OF E - Z MINI STORAGE, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPLACING THE MONUMENTS ON LOT NO. 2 OF PARTITION PLAT NO. 1994-01. IN RESEARCHING THIS JOB | GET RECORDS OF SURVEY FOR A SURVEY BY THE CITY OF PENDLETON FOR THE ALIGNMENT OF THE AIRPORT ROAD (L-28-C)DATED 3/76, THE CITY OF PENDLETON'S OLD LAND FILL SITE (85-131-C) DATED 8/76, AND SEVERAL SURVEYS FOR GENE RODEN (L-43-A, Q-1211-B, AND S-43-B) BY KRUMBEIN ENGINEERING, ALL PRIOR TO THE PARTITION PLAT 1994-01. I BUILD A MAP ENTERING DATA FROM ALL SURVEYS WHICH HOLD THE SAME BEARING BASE AND DISTANCES. THERE IS GOOD CLOSURE AND HARMONY BETWEEN ALL THE FOUND SURVEY RECORDS. IN SEARCHING FOR THE CORNERS I FIND SEVERAL MONUMENTS FROM SURVEY 85-131-C, WHICH ARE TIED TO SURVEY L-28-C. MANY ARE RELATIVELY CLOSE TO THEIR CALCULATED POSITION, ALTHOUGH BENT OR APPARENTLY DISPLACED BY EXCAVATION ACTIVITY THAT HAS OCCURED OVER THE LAST 30 YEARS. MONUMENTS FOUND AND RELATIVE POSITION TO THEIR CALCULATED POSITION ARE NOTED. IF THEY ARE WITHIN 0.10' THEY ARE SHOWN AS RECORD. ALL BUT TWO OF THE INTERIOR MONUMENTS SET FOR RODEN HAVE BEEN DESTROYED DURING APPARENT GRADING AND MINING OPERATIONS. THE TWO REBAR FOUND ARE ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE 5.0 ACRE TRACT CREATED BY SURVEY L-43-A. THE EASTERNMOST REBAR IS IN A SMALL RAVINE, PROTRUDING APPROXIMATELY 12" OUT OF THE GROUND, AND IS 2.0 FEET NORTH AND 1.4 FEET WEST OF IT'S CALCULATED POSITION. THE WESTERMOST REBAR IS 0.6 FEET NORTH AND 1.4 FEET WEST OF IT'S CALCULATED POSITION, AND SITS IN A SMALL MOUND ABOVE THE SURROUNDING GROUND SURFACE. I CAN NOT FIND ENOUGH EVIDENCE TO MAKE ANY CONCLUSION AS TO WHY THESE MONUMENTS ARE SO FAR OUT OF POSITION, WHEN EVERYTHING ELSE FOUND IS TYPICALLY WITHIN 0.15 OR LESS. I CAN ONLY SPECULATE THAT THEY HAVE BEEN MOVED DURING THE EXCAVATION ACTIVITIES IN THE AREA. AN EXTENSIVE SEARCH AFTER TYING THE FOUND MONUMENTS GAVE US A TIGHT SEARCH AREA, NO OTHER MONUMENTS WERE FOUND. BILL COLE STATED THAT EXCAVATION ACTIVITIES ON HIS PROPERTY HAD EITHER BURIED OR DESTROYED THE REMAINING INTERIOR MONUMENTS OF THE RODEN SURVEYS. WANTING TO MAINTAIN THE INTEGRITY AND HARMONY WITH THE EARLIER SURVEYS ! CONTACT THE OWNERS OF RECORD FOR THE SAID ADJOINING PROPERTIES, BEING E. W. (WOODY) CLARK, AND WILLIAM R. & JANICE MORGAN, AND WAS GRANTED PERMISSION TO RESET THE ERRANT MONUMENTS. MONUMENTS WERE SET AS NOTED ON THIS SURVEY.
