

NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

THIS SURVEY WAS ORDERED BY MIKE BAILEY, TO MONUMENT THE BOUNDARIES OF LOTS 1, 2, 3, AND THE EAST HALF OF LOTS 12, 13, AND 14 OF BLOCK 123 OF RESERVATION ADDITION, CITY OF PENDLETON, UMATILLA COUNTY, OREGON. I USED WILLIAM R. WELLS SURVEY NO. 04-129-G AS MY INITIAL BASIS OF BEARING AND UTILIZED THE POSTED STATE PLANE COORDINATES AS A CHECK TO THE MONUMENTS TIED IN RESERVATION ADDITION. MY FOUND DATA MATCHES

I THEN COMPARED THE SCALED DISTANCES AND ROTATED BEARINGS TO THE RECORD ON THE RESERVATION ADDITION PLAT. I FOUND THAT MY DISTANCES AND ROTATED BEARINGS WERE VERY CLOSE, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE DISTANCE BETWEEN RB NO. 14 AND RB NO. 13.

I HELD THE LINE BETWEEN RB NO. 8 AND RB NO. 14 AS "BASIS OF BEARING" AND WORKED TO THE SOUTH THROUGH BLOCK 123. I CALCULATED ON TO THE SOUTH LINE OF THE RESERVATION ADDITION, BUT THERE SEEMS TO BE SOME DISCREPANCIES WHERE THE ANGLES IN THE SUBDIVISION COME TOGETHER FROM THE SOUTH. I TRIED WORKING THROUGH A LARGE SECTION OF THIS AREA, BUT COULD NOT GET THE SAME RESULTS AS POSTED ON THE PLAT.

THE PROXIMITY OF THE LOTS BEING SURVEYED TO RB NO. 8 TO RB NO. 14, THE RELATIVE CLOSE FIT WITH THE CORNERS SET BY THOMPSON IN SURVEY NO. N-18-A, AND THE CALCULATED POSITIONS FITTING THE EXISTING LINES OF OCCUPATION VERY WELL, I ACCEPT THIS AS A BEST FIT SOLUTION. I SET TWO WITNESS CORNERS, ON LINE TO THE NORTH OF THEIR CALCULATED POSITION (AS NOTED) BECAUSE THEY FALL IN OR ON THE FACE OF A RELATIVELY NEW STACKED "SALVAGE" CONCRETE RETAINING WALL, AND A POURED-IN-PLACE CONCRETE RETAINING WALL THAT THE FACE APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN REPOURED RECENTLY. THE ORIGINAL WINGS TO THE SOUTH ARE STILL INTACT, BUT IT WOULD APPEAR THAT THE FACE WAS POURED FARTHER TO THE NORTH. THESE CORNER POSITIONS ARE BEST REFERENCED BY THE WITNESS CORNERS AND WILL PROVIDE THE OWNER WITH A BETTER MEANS TO CONSTRUCT

LOTS I, 2, AND 3, WHICH WERE RECENTLY PURCHASED BY MR. BAILEY, WERE PREVIOUSLY OWNED BY O.D.O.T.. AND DURING THEIR OWNERSHIP S.E. FRAZER PLACE WAS REALIGNED TAKING UP A GOOD PORTION OF LOT I. AT THE DATE OF THIS SURVEY THE CITY OF PENDLETON HAS RECEIVED A SIGNED DEDICATION OF THE NORTHEAST HALF OF LOT I TO THE CITY FOR PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY. THE CITY OF PENDLETON IS IN THE PROCESS OF GETTING THESE DOCUMENTS RECORDED.

I FIND NOTHING OUT OF THE ORDINARY BEYOND THE ITEMS MENTIONED ABOVE. CORNERS WERE MONUMENTED AS NOTED AND SHOWN ON THIS MAP. A SOKKIA GSR2700 IS REALTIME KINEMATIC GPS SYSTEM AND A SOKKIA SET 500 TOTAL STATION WERE USED TO PERFORM THIS SURVEY.
