

NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of Patrick Marolla, on behalf of Hancock Forest Management, land manager of the land within. Mr. Marolla wanted select property corners set and portions of the line marked with steel fenceposts prior to a timber harvest. I recover the monuments as shown hereon. I subdivide the section as per BLM Manual of Instructions 2009. I find no unusual condtiions with this survey.

BASIS OF BEARING

True geodetic North at the Southwest corner of Section 19, Township 1 North, Range 35 East of the Willamette Meridian, as determined by GPS observation
