NARRATIV

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF TOM BEECHINOR TO ADJUST THE BOUNDARY COMMON WITH YENNEY TO FOLLOW THE RIGHT OF WAY OF PIKES PEAK ROAD.

TO DEVELOP PARCEL BOUNDARIES OF THE TRACTS TO BE ADJUSTED, WE HAVE PERFORMED AN EXTENSIVE ANALYSIS OF THE ORIGINAL SURVEYS OF 15, 16, AND 22, AND OF THE DEPENDENT RESURVEY PERFORMED BY THE BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT IN 1965 AND 1966. IT HAS BEEN OUR CONCLUSION THAT THOUGH THE ORIGINAL CORNERS AT THE CLOSING CORNER ON THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 16 AND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16 ARE STILL IN PLACE, SECTIONS 15 AND 14 WERE FRAUDULENTLY SURVEYED BY ODELL. THE PLAT AND FIELD NOTES INDICATE ROADS AND TOPOGRAPHIC FEATURES IN VIRTUALLY IMPOSSIBLE POSITIONS, AND NO EVIDENCE OF THE CALLED FOR MONUMENTS EXIST. AN ANALYSIS OF THE BLM SURVEY CLEARLY INDICATE EXTENSIVE PROPORTIONING, AND ADOPTION OF UNRECORDED MONUMENTS OR EVIDENCE, WERE REQUIRED FOR THEM TO COMPLETE THEIR SURVEY.

FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY, WE HAVE ADOPTED CORNER POSITIONS BY THE METHODS SHOWN HEREIN. A COMPLETE RE-SURVEY OF TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 37 EAST, IS OUTSIDE OF THE SCOPE OF THIS PROJECT, AND ENTIRELY UNNECESSARY FOR THE WORK REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THIS BOUNDARY LINE ADJUSTMENT. EXTENSIVE, INDEPENDENT SEARCHES FOR ODELL'S CORNERS IN SECTION 15 BY FLOWERS AND TOMKINS WERE MADE AND THE SOLUTION FOR THE SECTION BREAKDOWN USED HEREIN PROVIDES A REASONABLE AGREEMENT WITH LAND USES.

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AS A REAL TIME KINEMATIC SURVEY USING JAVA DUAL FREQUENCY RECEIVERS HAVING A PRECISION OF ONE CETIMETER +/- 1 PPM. MONUMENTS WERE VISITED IN SEPTEMBER, 2004.
