THE WORK WAS AUTHORIZED BY THE UMATILLA COUNTY SURVEYOR AND BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND FUNDED BY THE PUBLIC LAND CORNER

INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN TO THE DEPUTY SURVEYORS BY THE SURVEYOR GENERAL DISCOURAGED USING STONES FOR CORNER MONUMENTS UNLESS BEARING TREES EXISTED. THEREFORE, NEARLY ALL CORNERS WERE ESTABLISHED AS WOOD POSTS, WITH CHARRED STAKES, TRENCHES ETC .. LATER RETRACEMENT AND REESTABLISHMENT SURVEYS MADE BY EARLY COUNTY SURVEYORS USED STONES TO MARK CORNERS WHEN AVAILABLE. IN FARMED AREAS, MOST FENCES HAVE BEEN REMOVED, BUT EVIDENCE OF OLD FENCES, SUCH AS FIELD BERMS OR FIELD LINES, STILL EXIST, AND WERE UTILIZED TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE IN REESTABLISHING CORNER POINTS ON

IN MAKING THIS SURVEY WE UTILIZED UMATILLA COUNTY'S RECTIFIED COLOR IMAGERY, ON THE OREGON STATE PLANE COORDINATE SYSTEM, TO IDENTIFY POTENTIAL CORNER SEARCH AREAS BASED ON FIELD LINES, ROADS, FENCES, ETC., DETAILED SEARCH AREAS WERE IDENTIFIED USING A TRIMBLE PATHFINDER PRO-XR BEACON CORRECTED G.P.S. RECEIVER. WE CONSULTED ALL OLD ADMINISTRATION MAPS FOR THE PENDLETON-MCNARY TRANSMISSION LINE SOUTH OF THE


NARRATIVE, CONTINUED:

ALL RECORD SURVEYS FOUND IN COUNTY SURVEYOR OFFICE RECORDS, INCLUDING SURVEYS REPORTED IN RECORD OF PRIVATE SURVEYS, BOOKS 1 AND 2 WERE CONSULTED. WE ALSO UTILIZED 1956 (AND LATER). AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY FLOWN BY THE USDA FARM SERVICE AGENCY. LAND CORNER RECORD FORMS, FILED CONCURRENTLY WITH THIS SURVEY, SHOULD BE CONSULTED FOR INFORMATION ON EACH CORNER RECOVERED OR REESTABLISHED. ON THE RECORD OF SURVEY MAPS AND LAND CORNER RECORDS, WE REPORTED ONLY THOSE RECORDS PERTINENT TO RECOVERY OR REESTABLISHMENT OF THE CORNERS.

IN FARMED AREAS, WE BURIED MOST CORNER MONUMENTS BELOW THE SURFACE OF THE GROUND, TO AVOID DESTRUCTION. ON CORNERS BETWEEN OWNERSHIPS IN FARMED AREAS, WE PLACED A STEEL FENCE POST NEAR THE BURIED CORNER, ABOVE GROUND, WITH WITNESS SIGN ATTACHED. THE ADJUSTED CONTROL NETWORK FOR THIS SURVEY IS TIED TO THE LEAST SQUARES ADJUSTED CONTROL NETWORK MADE IN 1996 FOR THE CITY OF PENDLETON TOPOGRAPHIC MAPPING PROJECT. IN THAT CITY CONTROL NETWORK, TRIANGULATION STATIONS "PENDLETON, PID RB1366", "SPARKS, PID RB1372" AND "PENDAIR, PID RB1369" WERE HELD AS FIXED. COORDINATE VALUES REPORTED ON LAND CORNER RECORD FORMS ARE OREGON STATE PLANE COORDINATES, NORTH ZONE, NAD 83(91).

RECOVERED CORNERS AND CONTROLLING CORNERS WERE TIED WITH TRIMBLE 5700 GEODETIC G.P.S. RECEIVERS USING STATIC AND REAL TIME KINEMATIC METHODS, FROM ADJUSTED G.P.S. CONTROL POINTS ESTABLISHED FOR THIS SURVEY. REESTABLISHED CORNER POSITIONS WERE SET USING REAL TIME KINEMATIC METHODS AND VERIFIED BY SEPARATE OBSERVATIONS. SOME CORNER AREAS WERE OBSTRUCTED BY CANYONS OR VEGETATION. CORNERS IN THESE AREAS WERE SET OR TIED USING A SOKKIA SET 4B, FIVE SECOND TOTAL STATION OR LIETZ SET 3B THREE SECOND TOTAL STATION, BY MAKING SHORT MEASUREMENTS FROM CONTROL POINTS ESTABLISHED BY G.P.S. METHODS. CORNER ACCESSORIES WERE MEASURED WITH A STEEL TAPE AND COMPASS.


