

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by John C. Arnold under contract #551 dated March 19, 1890. His record reads: Set basalt stone, 16 x 8 x 8 ins., 12 ins. in ground for cor. to secs. 16, 17, 20 & 21, marked 3 notches on S. edge and 4 notches on E. edge; dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins, in each Sec. Cor., 5 1/2 ft. dist. Raised mound of earth, 2 ft. high x 4 1/2 ft. base over stone on N. hillside.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

The original stone, plainly chisled, firmly in place. The position fits the calls to the ravine very well.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
Set a 11/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/4" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the position of the original stone. Burried the stone upside down along the west side of the monument. Attached a county monument sign to a nearby 5" dbh Ponderosa pine.

For references, I set four, 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" orange plastic caps attached, stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below: an iron rebar bears N68°34'12"E, 28.98 feet; an iron rebar bears S33°28'24"E, 28.41 feet; an iron rebar bears S31°42'46"W, 41.97 feet; an iron rebar bears S76°33'08"W, 41.08 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA system 300 RTK GPS.
