At the corner point...Set an iron post,28 ins.long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins.diam.,10 ins.in the ground, to solid rock, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft.base, to top, with brass cap mkd. (as shown in corner diagram). Deposit corner stone alongside iron post.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found $2\frac{1}{2}$ iron pipe with $3\frac{1}{4}$ brass cap (as shown in corner diagram) in mound of stone.

A 38" ponderosa pine brs N52 $^{\rm O}$ E, 119.3' with scribing visible. A 27" ponderosa pine brs S26 $^{\rm L}$ OE, 65.4' with healed blaze.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set steel fence post next to corner with sign 54-9 & 54-2 attached.

New bearing trees established: A 19" ponderosa pine brs $S35_2^{10}$ E, 32.6' scribed 1/4S21 BT A 11" ponderosa pine brs $N46^{10}$ E, 79.6' scribed 1/4S16 BT.

New BT's have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9, painted face of blaze & a 6" red band around each BT.

Compass declination 180 East.
