At the corner point...Set an iron post,28 ins.long,2½ ins.diam.24 ins.in ground, with brass cap mkd.(as shown in corner diagram) from which a new bearing tree...A lodgepole pine 15 ins.diam.bears N51°E,57 lks.dist.mkd.\frac{1}{4}\$15 BT.

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found  $2\frac{1}{2}$  iron pipe with  $3\frac{1}{4}$  brass cap (as shown in corner diagram) in mound of stone.

A 17" ponderosa pine brs N501 oE, 37.5' with scribing visible. Badly rotted ponderosa pine stump size indeterminate, no scribing visible brs  $N6_4^{10}W$ , 29.8'. A 12" ponderosa pine snag brs  $S17_2^{10}E$ , 65.2' with scribing visible.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set steel fence post next to corner with sign 54-9 attached.

New bearing trees established:

A 14" ponderosa pine brs  $S8\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ , 43.9' scribed 1/4S22 BT. A 13" ponderosa pine brs  $S63^{\circ}W$ , 15.5' scribed 1/4S22 BT. A 12" ponderosa pine brs  $N40\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}W$ , 32.1' scribed 1/4S15 BT.

New BT's have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9, painted face of blaze & a 6" red band around each BT.

Compass declination 180 East.
