Set steel fence post next to corner with sign 54-9 & 54-2 attached.

New bearing tree established:

A 13" ponderosa pine brs N66'3/4°E, 162.0' dist. scribed T4SR32ES16 BT.

New BT has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3~&~54-9, painted face of blaze & a 6" red band around each BT.
