
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

None. Corner established as part of this survey.



## Description of corner evidence found:

Found a small stone mound S 72°E, 4' from corner point.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position established by survey...

Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 15" in ground to rock, surrounded with mound of earth and stone set steel fence post South of corner and attached signs 54-2 & 54-9. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A 21" ponderosa pine brs N07 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 186.9' scribed S1/16S20 BT. A 17" ponderosa pine brs S73 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E, 249.6' scribed S1/16S21 BT.

New BT's have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9, painted face of blaze & a 6" red band around each BT.

Compass declination 180 East.
