A 16" ponderosa pine bears N 20 1/2° E, 174.2 feet scribed "1/4 S6 BT" on double blaze. A 6" ponderosa pine bears S 31 1/2° E, 115.9 feet scribed "1/4 S6 BT" on double blaze. A blue "Deep 1" bears S 48 1/2° W, 31.5 feet buried 12" into the ground to bed rock. A 6" ponderosa pine bears N 71° W, 183.4 feet scribed "1/4 S1 BT" on double blaze. Tagged bearing trees with bearing object signs.

Placed bearing object sign under ground on North side of "Deep 1", magnetic marker.

LOCATION AND COMMENTS: 1956 Pilot Rock Lumber location poster in old fence jack identifies corner, (S37°E 36 Lks from corner). Corner is 22 feet West of North-South fence.

"Deep 1" refers to magnetic locator marker manufactured by Bernsten, Inc.
