Found original stone, call size, properly marked in a rock jack 20' West of corner. Found original trees as follows:

A 18" Pine, good condition, bears N68E, 75.9 ft., scribes visable. A 33" Pine, good condition, bears S62E, 37.0 ft., scribes visable. A 36" Pine, good condition, bears S61W, 64.7 ft., scribes visable. A 22" Pine, poor condition, bears N53W, 42.0 ft., scribes visable.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner

At corner point, based on BTs, I set 21 "x30" iron pipe with brass cap marked as shown, 22" in ground, raised mound of stone 7 ft. at base to top of cap, from which:

New BT

A 27" Pine bears N63W, 77.0 ft. marked T5S R30E S2 BT.

Nailed brass washer to BT blaze. Buried original stone South and along side pipe. Set steel fence post 5+ ft. South of corner.
Used steel tape and magnetic compasswith 20° E declination.

Measured to face of blaze of original BTs and center of new BTs.
