Found mound of stone, from which:

A 14" Fir, good condition, bears S72W, 41.8 ft., scribes visable. A 24" Pine, poor condition, bears N76W, 50.6 ft., scribes visable.

No marked stone was found.

Blazes on these BTs face this mound of stone. It is evident, an error was made in recording the original distances.

Description of monument and accessories i established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

In place of mound of stone, I set 2½"x30" iron pipe with brass cap, marked as shown, raised mound of stone, from which:

New BT

A 9" Fir bears N26E, 17.1 ft. marked \$55 T5S R30E BT.

Nailed brass washer to BT blaze. Set steel fence post 5+ ft. West of corner. Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 20° E declination. Measured to face of blaze on original BTs and center of new BTs.
