CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original comer establishment; Frank W. Campbell under G.L.O. contract number 468, dated April 12, 1883, set a basalt stone 15"x 10"x 8" marked"; on the west face. He dug pits 18"x 18"x 12" N. & S. of the corner and raised a mound of earth alongside the corner. He marked a BT:

G-21 DIAGRAM T58 R30E 311 312

A Pine, 5" dia., 878°W, 222 1ks...

Duane Griffith, PLS 644, in 1974 under contract with the Forest Service, found a stone of record size and marked "1" in a rock jack 4 ft. NE of the corner point, re-established from the original BT. At the corner point he set a 21 x 30" iron pipe with a brass cap marked as shown below. From the corner:

The original BT; A Pine, 12" dia., S780W, 146.5 ft.; with scribing visible, A new BT; A Pine, 12" dia., S210E, 81.1 ft.; marked: \$512 T5S R30E BT

T58 R30E

Description of corner evidence found:

I found a 21" iron pipe with a 21" brass cap marked:

3111312 1974 PLS 644

A Ponderosa Pine, 15" dia., \$79\frac{1}{2}0W, 146.5 ft.; with healed blaze.

A Ponderosa Pine, 16" dia., dead and down, stump bears \$180E, 81.1 ft.; with scribing visible ..

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

To maintain the corner I marked a new BT:

A Ponderosa Pine, 11" dia., N500E, 56.1 ft.; marked 1 S12 BT

BTs have blaze and a 6" band painted red, BT tags and "Land Survey Monument" signs. New BT has, additionally, an alum. "PLS 1832" washer nailed to the bottom of the blaze. There is a 6' steel fence post with a "Land Survey Monument" sign within 5' of the corner.

Measured to center of BTs using steel tape and staff compass. Magnetic declination set at 20°E (per PLS 644).
