A 12" Pine, good condition, bears S78W, 146.5 ft., scribes visable.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner

At corner point, based on BT, I set 22"x30" iron pipe with brass cap marked as shown, 20" in ground, raised mound of stone 7 ft. at base to top of cap, from which:

New BT

A 12" Pine bears S21E, 81.1 ft. marked \$\$12 T5S R30E BT.

Nailed brass washer in BT blaze. Buried original stone North and along side pipe. Set steel fence post 5+ ft. North of corner.
Used steel tape and magnetic compasswith 20° E declination. Measured to face of blaze on original BT and center of new BT.
