Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

In position of stone, I set 21 x30, iron pipe with brass cap marked as shown, 24" in ground, from which:

· New BT

A 12" Pine bears S61W, 93.6 ft. marked \$58 T5S R30E BT. Buried stone north and alongside pipe. Nailed brass washer to BT blaze. Set steel fence post 5± ft. South of corner, Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 20° E declination. Measured to face of blaze of original BTs and center of new BTs.
