Found original stone, call size marked 4, 10" in the ground, from which:

Original BT

A 40" Pine snag bears S70W, 89.0 ft., scribes visable.

Found no evidence of other BT.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

In position of stone, I set 21 x30" iron pipe with brass cap marked as shown. 22" in ground, raised mound of stone 6 ft. at base to top of cap, from which:

A 9" Pine bears N38W, 55.4 ft. marked \$\$12 T5S R30E BT. A 10" Pine bears S68W, 33.1 ft. marked \$13 T5S R30E BT.

Nailed brass washer to BT blazes.

Corner of fences running South and West bears N30E, 6.0 ft.

Buried original stone North and along side pipe.

Set steel fence posts 5+ ft. South and 5+ ft. West of corner.

<u>Used steel tare</u> and magnetic compass with 20° E declination.

REGISTERED Measured to face of blaze on original BT and center of PROFESSIONAL new BTs.
