A 18" Pine, good condition, bears S39E, 18.5 ft., blaze healed. North-South fence attached to this tree. A 27" Pine, good condition, bears S42W, 76.6 ft., scribes visable.

No evidence of other BTs and could not identify original marked stone.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At corner point, based on original BTs, I set $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" iron pipe with brass cap, marked as shown, 24" in ground, from which:

A 14" Pine bears N78E, 45.1 ft. marked T5S R31E S7 BT.
A 10" Pine bears N28W, 31.3 ft. marked T5S R30E S12 BT.

Nailed brass washer to BT blaze. Set steel fence post 5t ft. East of corner Raised mound of stone 5 ft. at base to top of cap.
Used steel tape and magnetic compasswith 20° E declination. Measured to face of blaze on original BTs and center of new BTs.
